

PACK 195 PINWOOD DERBY PROCEDURES

When you and your scout build your Pinewood Cars, please make sure that you follow all of the attached rules. Pack 195 does inspect each car to ensure compliance, and those that do not comply are disqualified. This may seem harsh, but these are the same procedures that the Japeechen District will use. Remember, the top 3 finishers of the Pack 195 races will qualify to race in the district.

RACE SCHEDULE

Friday Evening

- **Preliminary weigh-in** – Tables will be set up with scales and tools. This is the time for final tune-up and adjustment to make sure your car weighs no more than 5 oz. **USE OF GRAPHITE POWDER IS NOT PERMITTED INSIDE ST. CATHERINE'S CHURCH HALL. ALL LUBRICATION MUST TAKE PLACE OUTSIDE.**
- **Final Inspection** – Once you are finished, and the judges are ready, take your car for final inspection. If it does not pass you can make repairs. Once it passes, it will be impounded until the race, **and no further work is permitted.** Once your car is impounded, you are free to go, or stay to watch family races.
- **Family / Sibling races** – The final event of Friday evening is the family race. These races are strictly for fun and cars for these races are not required to be inspected. Creativity in design for these racecars is encouraged.

Saturday – Race Day

- Racing Begins promptly at 9:00 AM
- Each scout will race 6 times – once in each lane of the track. Note Scouts who race in lanes 2 through 6 will race in the beginning, but finish at the end.
- Times will be added and a bracket of the 16 top finishers will be determined.
- The 16 top finishers will race (best of three) to determine the top 3 racers (and 1 alternate) who will be Pack 195's representatives for the District Race.
